

Record Ransomware Attacks: June 2023 Highest Month Ever Recorded

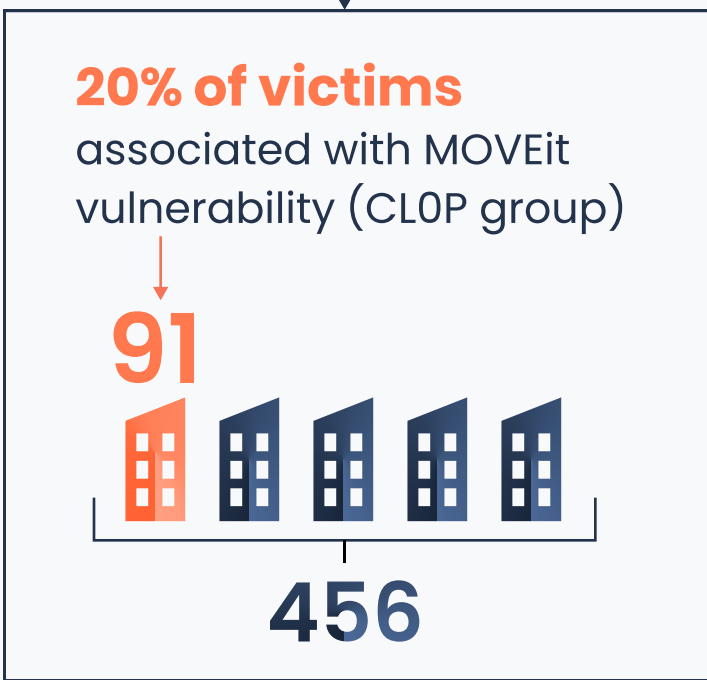
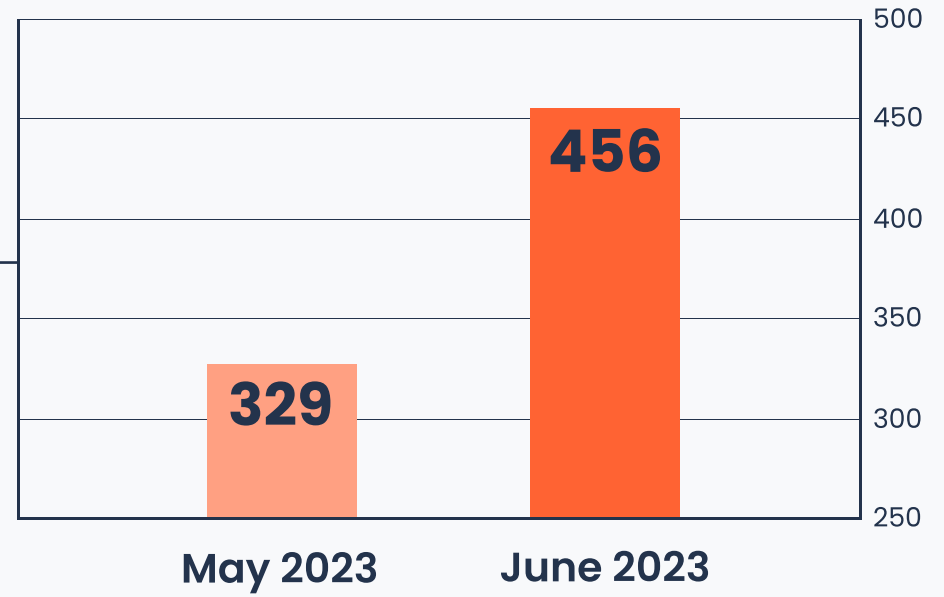
Ransomware broke another record. Here's what you need to know.



New ransomware victims on leak sites in June 2023

38% increase from May to June 2023

+38%



Much of June's spike is attributed to the ransomware group, CLOP. Their mass exploit of the zero-day vulnerability in MOVEit, a file transfer software, led to breaches at government agencies, healthcare firms, and massive enterprises.

Out of 29 active ransomware groups, CLOP alone accounted for nearly 20% of the total listed victims in June.

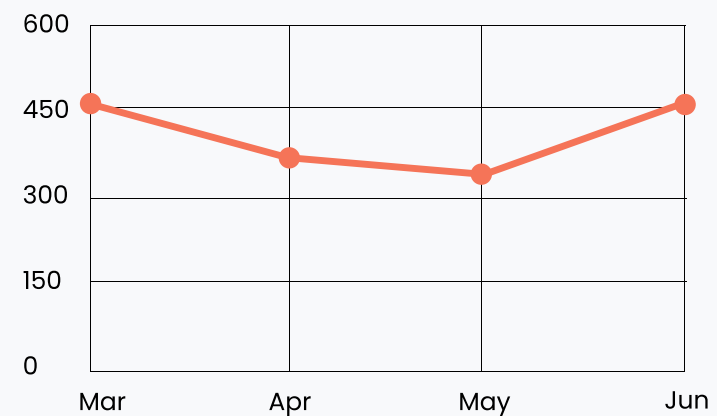

The number of ransomware victims on the dark web listed in June 2023 continues the alarming increase trend. This marks the **fourth month in a row with more than 300 victims listed on leak sites**, showing ransomware at a scale never seen before.
